

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

15th CONGRESS OF LOGIC, METHODOLOGY, AND PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE (CLMPS 2015)



Please prepare your proposal according to the submission guidelines below. All submissions should be sent by using the online form by 9 January 2015.

CONTRIBUTED PAPERS AND CONTRIBUTED SYMPOSIA

Contributed papers

Please submit an abstract of max. 300 words (title not included) prepared for anonymous review.

Accepted contributed papers will be allocated in total 30 minutes (20 min for the presentation + 10 min for the discussion).

Contributed symposia

Please submit an abstract of max. 1700 words (title not included) prepared for anonymous review:

The abstract should include:

- a. a general description of the format and the topic of the proposed symposium and its significance (up to 500 words)
- b. a 300-word abstract of each paper (3-4 papers)

Each accepted contributed symposia will be allocated a full two-hour session. The maximum number of papers in a symposium is 4 and the minimum 3.

AFFILIATED MEETINGS

Affiliated meetings are symposia that run parallel to the CLMPS 2015 programme, and belong to the congress programme. Affiliated meetings should last longer than the contributed two-hour symposia sessions, but should not be longer than one day or two half-days. Affiliated meetings will be announced on the congress webpage and on the congress programme book, and the congress organizers will arrange appropriate facilities (rooms etc.).

Affiliated meetings must meet the following conditions:

1. The programme must be approved by the Programme Committee
2. Each participant (speaker or not) of the affiliated meeting must be a registered participant of CLMPS 2015 or Logic Colloquium 2015.
3. The symposium is open to all participants of CLMPS 2015 and Logic Colloquium 2015.
4. The length of an affiliated meeting should not exceed one full day.
5. The CLMPS 2015 organizers should receive the final programme of the affiliated meeting to be included in the programme book by 30 April, 2015.

Proposals for affiliated meetings should be sent by using the CLMPS 2015 abstract submission form. Unlike other CLMPS 2015 submissions, affiliated meetings submissions are not blind-reviewed, and therefore **the abstract text should include:**

- a. The names and email-addresses of the organizer(s) and the speakers of the affiliated meeting with their homepage addresses.
- b. A description of the aim and scope of the meeting
- c. Short (max 300 words) abstracts of the planned talks
- d. A preliminary programme of the affiliated meeting

The maximum length of the affiliated meeting proposals is 4000 words.

RULES FOR MULTIPLE PRESENTATIONS

- + Maximally one contributed individual paper
- + One is allowed to present a second paper of which one is a co-author, but then the main author of this paper must submit the paper and be registered as a participant.
- + If one participates in a contributed symposia proposal, affiliated meeting proposal or is an invited speaker, one is not allowed to submit an individual contributed paper in which one is the main author (it is possible to be a co-author of a contributed paper, but then the main author of this paper must submit the paper and be registered as a participant).

ONLINE SUBMISSION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Using the CLMPS 2015 online abstract form to submit an abstract does not require registering. The online form has the following simple structure.

1. Abstract information
2. Author information
3. Content
4. Preview and submitting

Instructions for each online form section:

Abstract information

- Select the type of abstract (a contributed paper, a contributed symposium, or an affiliated meeting)
- Select the relevant CLMPS programme section
- Title of the abstract

Author information

- Contributed papers: please provide the information of all the authors and specify the first/presenting author
- Contributed symposia/affiliated meetings: please provide the information of all the symposium/meeting participants and organizers

Abstract content

- There are two ways to submit your abstract:
 - 1. The preferred way: use the abstract text field**
 - Write down or copy/paste your abstract text to the abstract text field (without the title).

 - If your abstract contains any illustrations or tables, you can attach these separately (jpeg. or gif. for illustrations).
 - 2. The optional way: not using the abstract text field**
 - If you have written your abstract by using LaTeX or if the abstract contains logical symbols etc. you can attach the abstract as a separate TeX-file. In this case you also need to attach a separate pdf-file in which all logical symbols are visible as they are to appear in the typeset abstract. Max. file size 1 MB.
 - You can also choose this option if you do not succeed in submitting your abstract by using the abstract text field. In this case, please submit a doc. file of your abstract + a PDF-file. Max. file size 1 MB.

Preview and submitting

- Please check carefully that all the information that you have provided is correct. Be extra careful in checking the preview PDF of the abstract text (if you have used the abstract text field). NOTE: the pdf preview does not show the names of attachments – so do not worry, if the attachments do not show in the pdf preview.
- The pdf print preview of the abstract requires that you temporarily allow pop-up windows.
- When you have checked all the information, you are ready to submit.
